A Sinological Summer School in Saint Petersburg (August 21–25, 2017)

The second Summer School “**Traditional China: a closer distant view**” (August 21-25, 2017) at the Faculty of Asian and African Studies of St. Petersburg State University, focuses on important matters of the present-day Chinese studies in Russia.
