The Center for Chinese Studies (CCS) at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa is launching and organizing the first Hawai'i International Conference on Chinese Studies (HICCS). This annual conference will provide a venue for scholars and educators in Chinese Studies to discuss the future directions of research on China and Chinese-speaking communities throughout the world. The interdisciplinary atmosphere will give scholars and advanced graduate students an international forum on the pedagogical challenges and intellectual complexities of Chinese cultures worldwide.

\$250 for registrations paid before September 15, 2019

\$300 between September 16 and December 1, 2019

\$350 thereafter
