October 1, 2019, marks exactly 70 years since the establishment of the People’s Republic of China. It is an opportunity to summarize, look at the current heritage of post-war China, both successes and failures, as well as the challenges that the country is facing. Over the past seven decades, dynamic changes have covered a whole range of aspects shaped by the PRC policy, not only the economic sphere and foreign policy, but also language, literature, philosophy, law and culture.
